WASOC will offer a club award to any dogs completing a Title at these trials

Entry Fees:

Pre-entry: \$20 per class. Special pre-entry discount: enter a dog in two Obedience classes and two Rally classes for \$70 (\$15 for each additional class that dog is entered).

Day-of-trial entry: \$25. There is no discount for multiple classes. If available, day-of-trial will be taken up to 45 minutes prior to the start of each trial; please contact the Trial secretary ahead of time to verify the availability of day-of-trial entries.

Juniors: Juniors receive a 50% discount on the pre-entry/day-of-trial entry fees.

Pre-entry opens Monday, July 1, 2024. Entries postmarked before opening will be returned.

Pre-entry closes on Monday, September 30, 2024 or when the judging limit is reached. (Judging is limited to 8 hours per day.) Entries received after the closing will be put on a waiting list. Entries may be withdrawn until the Pre-entry closing. Thereafter, no refunds.

All entries must be on the official ASCA entry forms. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of the entry and the classes entered. The current ASCA entry forms are available at:

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOWGROUNDS: 3987 N Livermore Ave, Livermore, CA

From Tracy: Take I-580W. After descending the Altamont pass, exit at N Livermore Ave (the fourth exit). At the end of the off ramp turn right (north). Continue about 2 miles. The showground is on the right.

From San Jose: Take I-680N to I-580E (toward Livermore). Continue about 10 miles: exit at N Livermore Ave. At the end of the off ramp turn left (north). Continue about 2 miles. The showground is on the right.

Directions to Sage: left out of property onto N Livermore Ave; right onto I-580 W; in 7 miles exit at Dougherty Rd; turn right at end of off ramp and immediately merge into the left lanes; left turn at first light onto Dublin Blvd; in about one mile pass under the freeway; then at the traffic light turn right onto Amador Plaza Rd; in about 0.2 miles Sage is on the right, immediately past the REI.

ASCA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

TO ENTER THESE TRIALS dogs must be six (6) months or older, and must have an individual ASCA registration, ASCA LEP number or an ASCA QTracker number. An application form with instructions for securing a Qtracker number is available at <https://asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/06/qtsvcapp.pdf>. Forms will also be available at the trials. Please contact the ASCA Business office (contact info is available on the form) with any questions about completing the form.

No entries can or will be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Rally or Obedience programs; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

Bitches in heat will not be allowed to compete in these trials.

As is typical for ASCA trials, lunch will not be provided. However, there are many dining options along I-580 or N Livermore Ave within five miles of the trial site. Use your phone's map application to locate one, or ask the property owner on trial day for a suggestion.

And, of course, COVID considerations:

1. DO NOT COME IF YOU FEEL SICK!!! (You know the drill...)
2. Please follow all COVID-related best practices and federal/state/local requirements.
